**James, Furse
 Attend Science
 Symposium**

Two Mercer Chemistry Department staff members, Dr. F. W. James and Dr. C. T. Furse attended the 1964 Eastern Analytical Symposium and Instrumental Exhibit which was held Nov. 10 to 13 in New York City.

The meeting was sponsored by the American Chemical Society, the Society for Applied Spectroscopy and the American Microchemical Society.

Dr. James indicated that many of the papers to be given by authorities in the field of instrumental analysis will be of particular value to Dr. Furse and himself in the continued up-grading and modernization of instruction in analytical chemistry. Significant improvements have been made in this area of the chemistry curriculum in the past three years as the result of purchases of needed equipment. It was pointed out by Dr. James that analytical chemistry is one of the most rapidly expanding fields of chemistry and he is pleased with Mercer's improving program.
