

TWO CUB GAMES ARE ANNOUNCED

Freshmen Diamonders Will Play Gordon and Barnesville Aggies

The next two games of the Mercer freshman baseball schedule for this season were announced Thursday by Coach Albert Sidney Johnson, who will have charge of the Club diamonders. Gordon Institute will be played by the freshmen at Barnesville on April 13 and Barnesville at Gordon on April 14.

A trip to South Georgia is being contemplated by the Mercer men, and the following games will be played: Barnesville at Gordon on April 25-26; Vidalia High School on April 27; and South Georgia College at Griffin on April 28-29.

Practice for the freshmen began last week and approximately forty games dates reported in answer to Coach Johnson's call. Spring football practice has been becoming Johnson's main job with the end of football training today, he will devote all of his attention to the freshman baseball candidates.

Last year the Cubs won over all opposition and much of Mercer's varsity strength is due to its sophomore players. The freshman material at Mercer now includes some of the finest prep school stars in the state.
