

TRIBUNAL CEASES YEARS' ACTIVITIES

Students With Meal Ticket Numbers Unmatched Will be Prosecuted

The Student Tribunal will not convene hereafter unless a special hearing is called, according to Joe Chappel, judge of the judiciary body.

The judge explained that since the Seniors had abolished the rules and regulations governing the freshmen, the work of the Tribunal will be considerably reduced.

Have Grand Jury

A "Grand Jury" has been functioning since the Christmas holidays. This body is a joint committee composed of three members of the faculty discipline committee and two members of the Tribunal. The former are Dr. Montague, Prof. Smalley and Mr. Garrett, registrar. The students are represented by Carlton Mobley, solicitor of the Tribunal, and Joe Chappel, judge.

This marks an innovation in the student judiciary system. Heretofore, warrants were sworn out by any up-pleasman who saw a student in any act of misconduct. Subpoenas were then served accordingly by Sheriff Darby Cannon. The sheriff's duties, of course, will continue unchanged while the "Grand Jury" will investigate all matters pertaining to the conduct of students. This body then will turn the case over to the student Tribunal for final settlement.

Garrett Warns Students

Warning is hereby officially issued by Mr. Garrett that students whose meal tickets the numbers of which do not correspond with those on the registrar's books will be subject to prosecution by the Student Tribunal.

Attention is called to the fact that when students buy meal tickets for use at the Mercer Cafeteria the numbers on these tickets are recorded on the registrar's books. Therefore, it is pointed out, the student lays himself open to suspicion when he appears at the treasurer's office with other than his own meal book to get another one and to take advantage of the one dollar allowance for the old cover.

Return Books Found

The officials state that the various and sundry explanations offered by the students who overlook this point do not justify their taking advantage of meal tickets, lost, found or stolen. It is suggested that tickets of this character be returned to the treasurer's office to avoid the embarrassment of appearing before the Tribunal.

SPRING PRACTICE SOON FOR BRUINS

Football Workouts to Get Under Way First Week in March

MUST REPLACE STAR TRIO

Spring football practice will get under way at Mercer the first week in March, according to an announcement made this week by Coach Bernice Moore. Close to fifty candidates for positions on the 1928 Mercer varsity are expected to report at the initial workout.

During the weeks of spring workouts men must be found to take the place of Mercer's famous football trio, Wallace Butts and Chariton "Bit" here in the line, and "Phoney" Smith in the backfield. Coach Moore also expects to develop many more reserves than were on the squad last season.

Several prospects from last year's women team furnish excellent line and backfield material. Newsome, Arvin, and Matt in the backfield and Sewell, Branch, Kerr, and Freeman are promising of developing into good steady candidates, as do practically the entire freshmen team of 1927. The sub team of last year was the only football team in the history of Mercer athletics to win over a University of Georgia eleven.

BRUIN BASEBALL NINE WILL MEET TECH IN ATLANTA

Games in April Mark Resumption of Relations After Three Years

NOTRE DAME OPENS CARD

After a lapse of three years Mercer will resume athletic relations with Georgia Tech. when the Mercer baseball team meets the Yellow Jacket baseball team on Grant field April 13, in the first of a two-game series. A second game will be played the following day. The announcement was made this week by Coach Bernice Moore.

Mercer baseball schedule this year will include the three major college baseball teams in Georgia, according to the coach's announcement.

The University of Georgia will be played in Athens, April 20-21, and a three-game series will be played with the Oglethorpe Petrels, probably April 26, 27, 28. The dates have not been definitely fixed.

Notre Dame will furnish the Mercer diamond artists opposition in the initial games of the season, the Bears meeting the representatives of that college on the local diamond, April 6 and 7.

Coach Moore is trying to arrange a three-game series with Camp Benning, and with the Florida "Gators."

A total of fourteen games will probably be played this season, the Bear coach announced.

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
