chapter for him. Alpha Delta will be known as the William Hansel Fish chapter of Phi Alpha Delta, being named in honor of Judge Fish, who was Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Georgia from 1906 to 1922, Dean of the Mercer University Law School, 1922-'25; and Dean Emeritus of the law school until his death in 1926. This is the second legal fraternity to place a charter here, Theta Phi having been installed on February 4 as the Joseph Rucker Lamar senate of Delta Theta Phi, national legal organization.

Has Fifty-one Chapters

At present Phi Alpha Delta has fifty-one chapters. Those nearest Mercer are located at the University of Florida, Emory University, University of Alabama, University of Tennessee, Stetson University, University of Virginia, University of North Carolina, Washington and Lee University, University of Kentucky and Tulane University. The national fraternity was organized by several of the law schools of Chicago in 1897.

The alumni members of Phi Alpha Delta in Macon are, Prof. Paul W. Brozman, Prof. Floyd A. Wright and Prof. C. Baxter Jones, of the Mercer law school faculty, and McKibben Lane and Walter J. Grace, all of whom were influential in securing the approval of a Mercer chapter of the national legal order.
