

BOARD WILL ACT ON SUGGESTIONS

of the university.

The major changes adopted by the survey committee which will be submitted to the trustees for final action this afternoon are as follows:

"1. That the president of the university shall be the sole executive of the institution, clothed with full au-

thority and responsible only to the board of trustees.

Raise Arts School

"2. That the school of Liberal Arts be made the simple unit in the university, its standard elevated and its faculty strengthened.

"3. That the Theological Seminary be adjusted to the status of a pre-theological school, and its work correlated with that of the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary and other standard schools.

"4. That the Law School be continued as a standard law school and the committee instructed to proceed with their plans for securing funds from the alumni and other friends of the law school for the purpose of erecting a law building. This is absolutely necessary in order that school may retain its present rating as a standard school. The committee was also requested to solicit endowment funds, in order that the law

school may be put on an independent basis as soon as possible.

Careful Budget Asked

"5. That each department of the university be carefully budgeted, and its expenditures strictly limited to the amount of its budget. It is the purpose of the board, heartily seconded by the newly elected president, that the appropriations shall be fully within the expected income, thus avoiding deficits in the future."

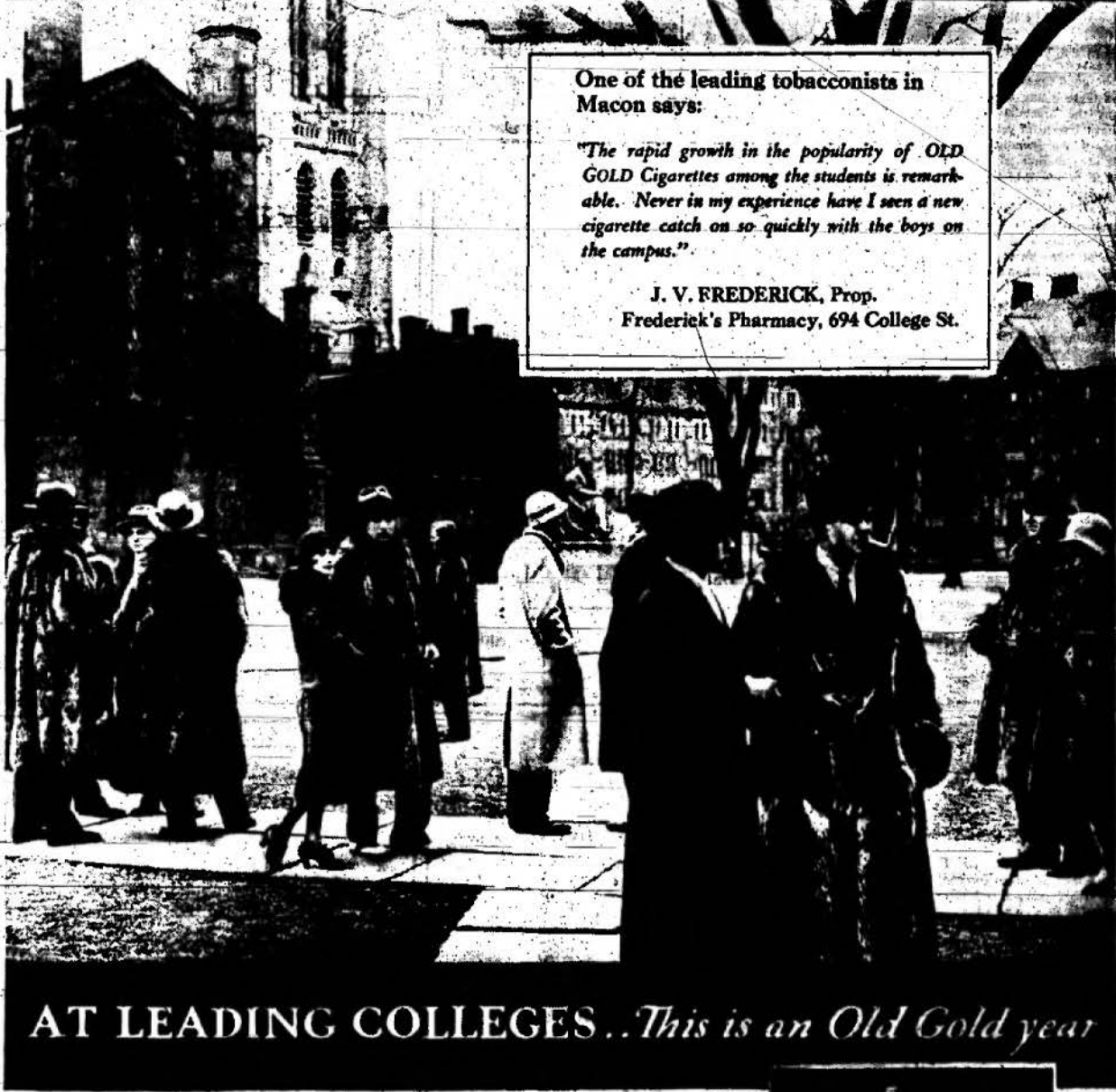
