(Continued from Page 1) a central heating plant, to remodel the laundry, and to provide a gymnasium. All of the projects would be self liquidating, said Dr. Dowell. The economy of the plan was shown to the convention by President Dowell. The heating plant would eliminate considerable janitor service and save much of the waste under the present system of heaters. The university has to use the Municipal Auditorium as a gymnasium now, which is costing a rather large amount of money.

Quannah Parker was a Comanche Indian Chief, son of a captive white woman. He led the last Indian attack against the Texans, but later accepted and championed white civilization. He negotiated leases of Indian lands for pasture, was delegate of his people on missions to Washington, was appointed judge of an Indian court, and early in the Twentieth century was mentioned as a candidate for the United States senate. He died in 1911.

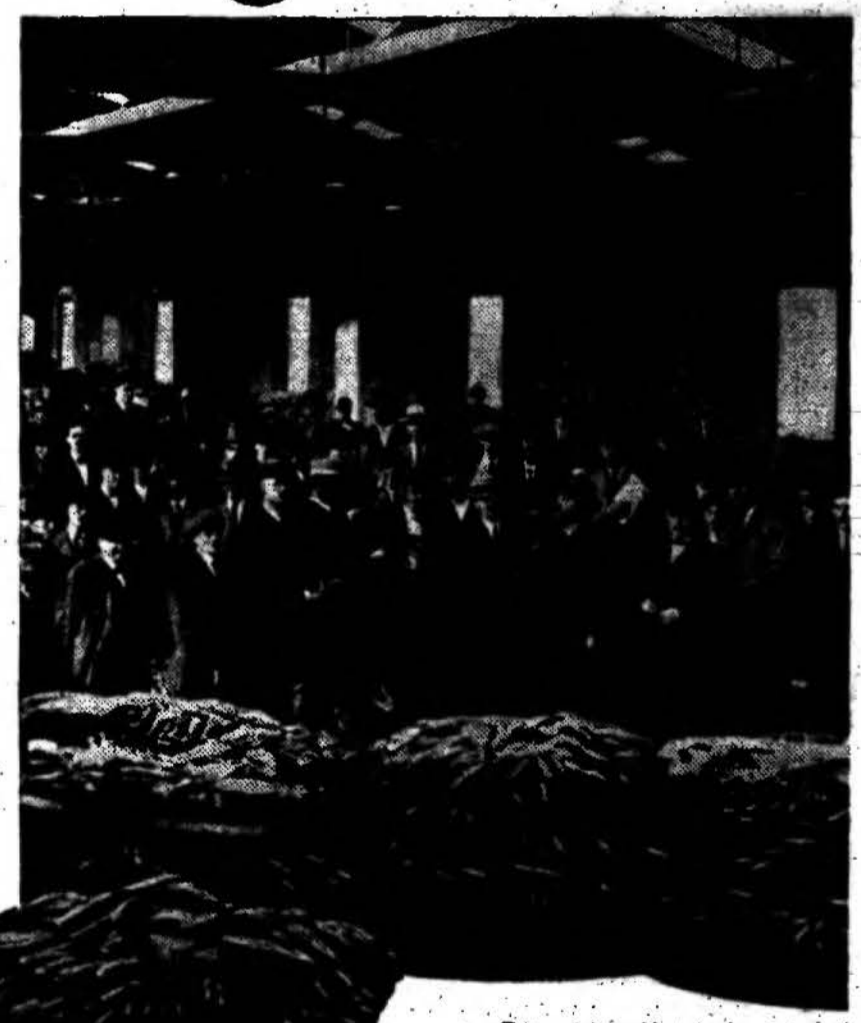

There are 6 types of home-grown tobaccos that are best for cigarettes

- BRIGHT TOBACCOS**
U. S. Types 11, 12, 13, 14.
 - BURLEY TOBACCO**
U. S. Type 31.
 - SOUTHERN MARYLAND TOBACCO**
U. S. Type 32.
- U. S. Type 11 is produced in the Piedmont Belt of Virginia and part of North Carolina.
U. S. Type 12 is produced in eastern North Carolina.
U. S. Type 13 grows in South Carolina.
