

Ninth Annual Inter - Civic Dinner Held

Speaker Believes Dictators Will Lose

Lafayette college president, Dr. William Mather Lewis, spoke to guests at the ninth annual Inter-Civic dinner held Tuesday night in the Hotel Dempsey Walter Little room.

Twelve civic clubs throughout the state were represented at the banquet by approximately three hundred persons.

Dr. Spright Dowell, president of Mercer, introduced Dr. Lewis after the invocation by Dr. Dice Anderson, Wesleyan college president. Dr. Hansford Johnson, head of the Mercer theology department, delivered the benediction.

War to the Finish

"Democracy and totalitarianism must fight it out," Dr. Lewis told the civic leaders, "until one has permanently destroyed the other." He also added that "I am not one of those who believes that the totalitarian nations will win this war."

Dr. Lewis challenged his listeners to demonstrate new loyalty and faith in the nation, and warned of the dangers of government decay that are sure to come if democracy is left to stand the test alone.

Praises Selective Service

"Unless we think more of the responsibilities of democracy than of the rights and privileges it provides, we will soon pass out of the picture as a no. 1 nation," he said. He spoke of the selective service program as "an amazingly fine thing for the youth of the nation as well as for the nation itself."

The speaker expressed the opinion that the decision of war or peace for the United States would have to be made well within the next three or four months.

Dr. Dowell, founder of the Inter-Civic dinner series, was the presiding officer at the banquet.
