Dr. Spright Dowell, president of Mercer, is a well-known figure on the campus, but we feel incoming freshmen should know more about him and his career.

A native of North Carolina, Dr. Dowell received his A.B. degree from Wake Forest College in 1896, also attending the University of Tennessee and Columbia, receiving an A.M. degree from Columbia and Teacher's College. He received his LL.D. from the University of Alabama and from Howard College.

Dr. Dowell started his career as principal of the elementary school in Shelley, Alabama, and in succession became principal of the Columbia High School, superintendent of schools at East Lake, principal of Barrett School in Birmingham, Alabama, chief clerk for Department of Education in Alabama, and director of teachers' training. Later he was appointed state superintendent of education by Governor Charles Henderson of Alabama.

Dr. Dowell was President of A.P.E. before becoming President of Mercer in 1928, and since 1930 he has been President of the Board of Trustees at Mercer.
