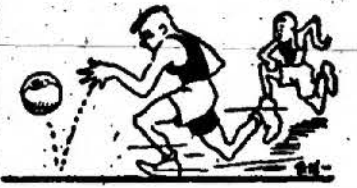
- Tues., Oct. 30—A D Pi vs Chi O.
