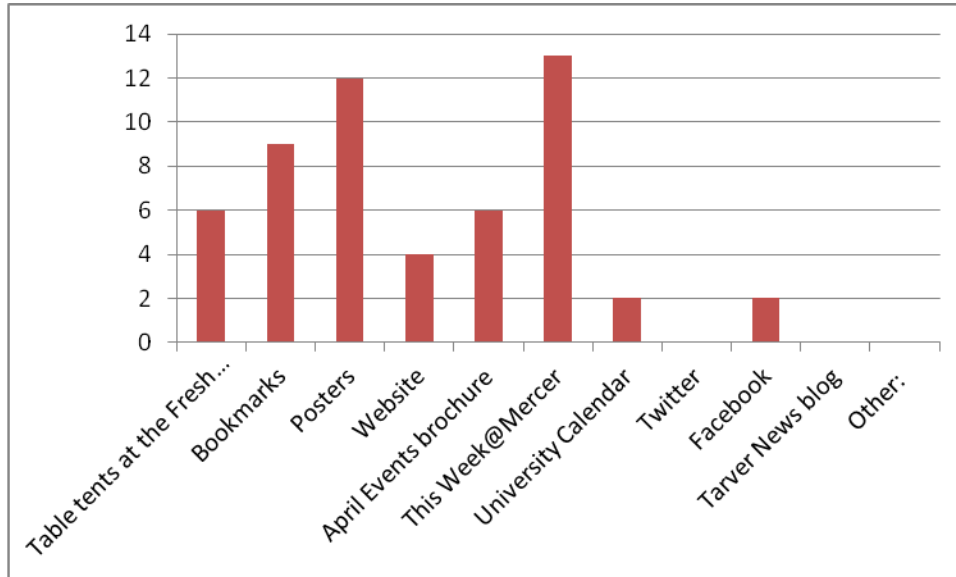
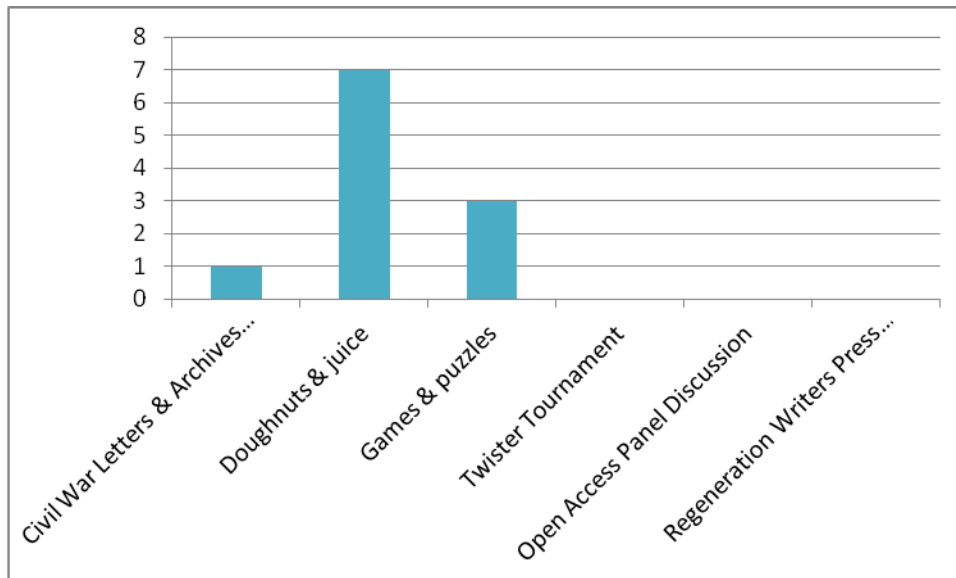


National Library Week Patron Survey – Results

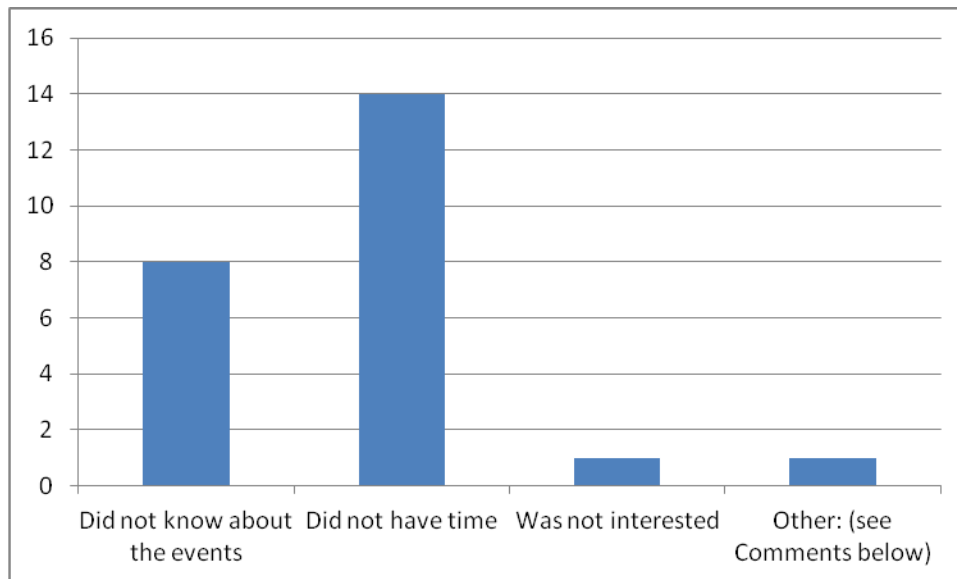
Did you see the following publicity for National Library Week (please circle all that apply):

If you did not attend/participate in any of the events, why? (please circle all that apply)



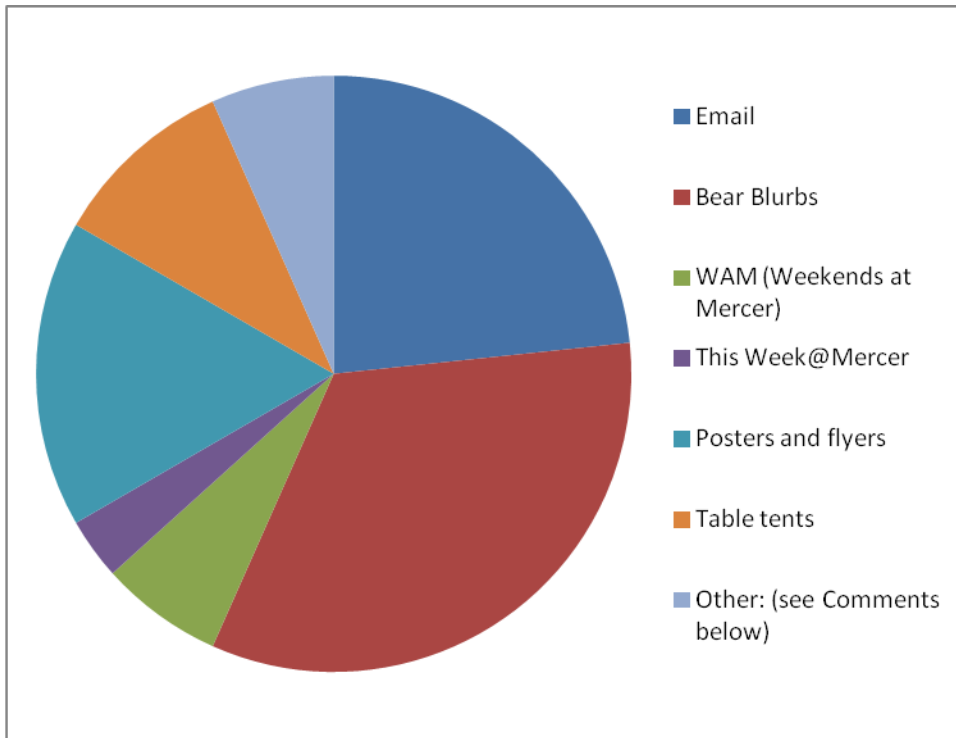
Comments:
