The adoption of the Uniform Commercial Code by all states, *but one*, and in particular the adoption of Section 1-105 requiring the courts to apply the law of the state to which the transaction, covered by the code, bears "an appropriate relation", marks a departure from the *lex loci contractus* and is suggestive of the significant relationship approach.
